Instructions for the Scout:

To appear before your Board of Review, you must be in a **full Class A uniform, including merit badge sash.**

Please bring the following items with you:

- Your *Boy Scout Handbook*
- This sheet with the appropriate blanks filled in with your own handwriting, using ink (no scratch-outs or erasures)

The Board of Review will cover the **minimum requirements** for the Life rank. You may also be asked questions about, or asked to demonstrate, any of the skills and requirements for Star, First Class, Second Class, Tenderfoot and Scout ranks.

A thorough review of the applicable sections in your *Boy Scout Handbook* is the best way to prepare. Come ready to discuss what you've learned and show what you can do!

1. Repeat from memory the Scout Oath and Law.
2. Be prepared to describe the Scout Badge.
3. Explain Scout Spirit and give an example of how you have demonstrated Scout Spirit recently.
4. Give a brief account of your service project work hours. These projects must be approved by your Scoutmaster. (This must be one or more service projects totaling at least 6 hours of work.)
5. There is a major difference between the service required for Star and Life and that required for Eagle. In the first two, you can be a follower. For Eagle, you must be a leader. You must plan, develop and give leadership to a project of help to your church, school or community. The project must be of value when finished. Explain to the board why you feel you are now prepared to begin an Eagle project.
6. Give a brief account of your accomplishments in your leadership Position of:
