## Instructions for the Scout:

To appear before your Board of Review, you must be in a **full Class A uniform, including merit badge sash.**

Please bring the following items with you:

- Your *Boy Scout Handbook*
- A compass
- A pocket knife
- A 3-foot length of rope
- This sheet with the appropriate blanks filled in with your own handwriting, using ink (no scratch-outs or erasures)

The Board of Review will cover the **minimum requirements** for the Second Class rank. You may also be asked questions about, or asked to demonstrate, any of the skills and requirements for Tenderfoot and Scout ranks.

A thorough review of the applicable sections in your *Boy Scout Handbook* is the best way to prepare. Come ready to discuss what you've learned and show what you can do!

1. Repeat from memory and explain in your own words the Scout Oath, Law, Motto and Slogan.
2. Explain in your own words the meaning of four points of the Scout Law selected by the board.
3. Explain what to do if lost in the woods.
4. Discuss the principles of leave no trace.
5. Identify four map symbols which are listed in the Boy Scout Handbook.
6. Orient a map, demonstrate how a compass works and take a bearing with a compass.
7. Demonstrate how to sharpen a knife and correctly pass it to another person. Tell the safety rules for using the following: knife, hatchet, ax, and bow saw.
8. Explain when it is appropriate to use a cooking fire and a light weight stove. Explain the safety procedures for the use of both.
9. Tell about a meal you prepared on a camp-out.
10. Tell about the service project in which you participated.
11. What is meant by the term "First Aid"?

12. Explain how to treat each of the following: "hurry" cases, burns and scalds, foot blisters, insect bites and stings, a sprained ankle, shock and object in eye.
13. Tell about what precautions must be taken for a safe swim and the three water rescue methods.
14. Tie and give one use for each of the following knots: Two half Hitches, Taut-Line Hitch and Square Knot.
15. Explain the three R's of personal safety and protection.
16. Explain Scout Spirit and give an example of how you have demonstrated Scout Spirit recently.
